The project involved extensive bank stabilization and required the specialized installation of a temporary water management system. The Williams Creek Team successfully executed this work in a uniquely sensitive environment by utilizing a fillable coffer dam. This innovative technique allowed the team to completely block and dewater the construction area and work in the dry without discharging sediment downstream.

The team's careful attention to detail and professional execution allowed them to successfully complete the technically complex work while adhering to strict limitations on stream channel disturbance. The use of the coffer dam was a key differentiator, minimizing impact to the stream bed and ensuring maximum environmental protection while stabilizing the bank.
